The duration of the Master in Finance is 2 years (Master 1 + Master 2) or 1 year (Master 2 only), depending on your background and latest degree.

- A 3-year Bachelor's Degree or a Licence 3 (at the minimum): You will complete the program in 2 years (M1 + M2).
- A 4-year Bachelor's Degree or a Master Degree (at the minimum): You will complete the program in 1 year (M2).

  If the commission board finds that your background is strong but not complete enough in some required aspects, we may ask you to complete the program in 2 years (M1 + M2) instead in order to build up your strengths and ensure your success.

## YEAR 1 - (MASTER 1; M1)

#### AT ESSEC FRANCE OR AT ESSEC ASIA-PACIFIC

Depending on your background and latest degree, you will start the program in M1 and the total duration of the program is 2 years (M1 + M2).

To build up your strength and help you build your foundations, you will begin the program with a term (T0) of preparatory courses in Finance, Mathematics and Statistics.

During the following term (T1), you will follow 6 courses from a general track (1 compulsory & 5 electives). Through this first year, you will be able to discover your professional interest, to help you decide on which track to choose in Year 2 (M2).

You will do a 6-month internship at the end of M1.

## YEAR 2 - (MASTER 2; M2)

Depending on your background and latest degree, you will start the program in M2 and the total duration of the program is 1 year (M2), or you will continue with the second year of the program (M2) if you started in M1.

This year (M2) is divided into three terms, where you will cover: courses, 2 study trips to the major financial centers (London and New York or Hong Kong), specialized tracks, certificates in FinTech & Analytics, Energy & Commodities, and/or AMF certification (optional), and an internship or academic dissertation.

#### **RESEARCH SEMINARS**

ESSEC Business School's Finance Department along with the Research Center holds research seminars throughout the academic year where guest speakers present the most recent theoretical and empirical research in finance.

#### OFFICIAL MASTER DEGREE

The Master in Finance (MIF) program is authorized by the French Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation to award a recognized BAC +5 degree, Master's Grade to its students, allowing them to apply to governmental financial aids and pursue doctoral studies afterwards.

At the end of the program, depending on which campuses students have studied at, they can apply for an Autorisation Provisioire de Séjour (APS) in France to extend their visa for 1 year and apply for jobs in Europe or a Long Term Visit Pass (LTVP) in Singapore to stay and look for employment for 1 year.

# STUDY TRIPS TO LONDON AND NEW YORK OR HONG KONG

The two study trips to the major financial centers in the world represent unique moments in the program.

During M2, students travel to two of the major financial centers (London, and New York or Hong Kong), where they meet and exchange views with professionals in the most prestigious investment banks and consulting firms such as Ardian, Barclay's Capital, Bank of America-Merrill Lynch, BNP-Paribas, CA CIB, Crédit Suisse, Goldman Sachs, Greenhill Partners, J.P. Morgan, KKR, Macquarie, Messier Partners, Natixis, Société Générale, Standard & Poor's and UBS.

The study trips are also the perfect opportunity to develop ESSEC network and meet alumni.

#### PEDAGOGICAL APPROACH

The program relies on a wide range of teaching methods including lectures, current events and case study analysis as well as in-class exercises.

# A SUPPORTIVE AND INVOLVED FACULTY BODY FROM ACROSS THE GLOBE

The three assets that best characterize ESSEC Business School's faculty are academic excellence, a global frame of mind and original and outstanding teaching.

The Finance Department's research covers a broad spectrum of key areas in finance: Financial Derivatives. Risk Management, Commodities, Portfolio and Wealth Management, Macro-Finance, Market Microstructure, Mergers and Acquisitions, Private Equity, Corporate Governance, Real Estate and Corporate Bankruptcy. Researchers have published their work in some of the world's most prestigious academic journals including the Journal of Financial Economics, Journal of Financial and Ouantitative Analysis, Journal of Banking and Organization, Journal of Econometrics, Review of Finance and Finance.

In addition to the faculty, the program also relies on lecturers and practitioners who are experts in their field.

Each year (M1 & M2), students will complete an internship with a duration of 4 to 6 months; it can take place anywhere in the world and is designed to facilitate students' professional integration. It enables them to apply their newly acquired skills and knowledge to hands-on-experience as interns within an organization.

## ALUMNEYE TRAINING TO PREPARE FOR SUMMER PROGRAM RECRUITMENT

Through its partnership with the CFA, Master in Finance students interested in taking the CFA exams (Level I, II or III) in June are eligible for a number of scholarships covering the exam fees.

Furthermore, every year, Master in Finance students represent ESSEC to the CFA Institute Research Challenge. In Feb 2019, ESSEC won the French final and qualified for the EMEA final.


