



Consultancy Pathway

Provides an essential platform for you to embark or progress your career in advisory and advanced service delivery environments. Designed to develop the skills needed for success in consultancy, you will learn from real situations and from expert speakers who will be invited to share their experiences with you.

Gain in-depth insight into the global consultancy industry, enhance your capabilities in management consulting and project management. Taught modules, case analysis, capability enhancement workshops and master-classes, enable the key competencies needed to excel within this global marketplace.

You will also have the opportunity to work with a local charity on a business issue and will apply your advanced critical, evaluative and communication skills to a real business situation, delivering tangible added value to a charitable cause.



Entrepreneurship Pathway

Explores new venture creation process, the theoretical perspectives on entrepreneurship, and entrepreneurship within corporations.

Modules, master-classes and debates aid understanding of these and help you to build your own unique brand of entrepreneurship. Social responsibility and ethics are embedded, focussing on social enterprise as a response to social demand. Diverse guest speakers describe their own journeys, allowing you to ask personally relevant questions. Access to business angels and venture capitalists, as well as legal, networking, and support services.

Themes include family businesses, social entrepreneurship, corporate intra/entrepreneurship, policy perspectives, and diversity issues. Framework issues – entrepreneurial strategy, management, leadership and HR practices, as well as team building and self-awareness, are also important pathway elements.


Technology Pathway

Technology continues to disrupt business. This pathway provides an in-depth knowledge of business analytics to give a critical insight into technology innovation. You will learn how to manage innovations, analyse and apply data to improve management decision-making, develop new products, and deliver them using an agile approach.

On this pathway you will increase your range of skills to interpret results and the relevance of them for your company. You will also learn how to choose appropriate techniques to apply to challenges and fully understand the role of technology as a 'game changer' in terms of creating new products or markets.

Through your learning, you will identify underlying drivers and future trends in technological innovations will become a key aspect of your leadership toolkit.

Entry requirements

Making the grade

The Durham MBA (Full-time) programme has the following entry criteria:

- Candidates must be able to demonstrate at least three years' continuous post-graduation work experience, in one or more positions with significant managerial responsibility.
- · An upper second class Bachelor Degree or international equivalent

Lack of formal qualifications is not necessarily a barrier to admission; managerial experience is also a key consideration for entry to our MBA programme.

How to apply

To apply using our online application form, or to find more information regarding entry requirements, supporting documentation, fees or scholarships, visit:

In such cases, we may ask you to submit a portfolio of evidence demonstrating capability in areas such as management experience, including critical thinking and communication skills.

Additionally, candidates whose first language is not English will normally be required to demonstrate evidence of proficiency in English language as follows: a recent English language test score of 7.0 or above in IELTS with no element below 6.0, or 102 or above in TOEFL IBT with no element below 23 or an alternative University approved English language test.
