Welcome to our Full-time MBA Graduate Destinations report, unveiling the achievements of our Class of 2021–2022. We take immense pride in highlighting the diverse array of roles, industries, and new geographical locations our students have accepted within three months of graduating from their Full-time MBA.

In the face of a challenging employment landscape, we are thrilled to report that, despite the uncertainty, 89 % of participants seeking employment accepted a job within three months of completing their Full-time MBA. 54 % of our graduates who secured job offers have successfully transitioned

to new sectors, while an impressive 70 % of the students that shared data on their location have ventured to a new geographical area. This highlights the immediate and positive impact that the Warwick Full-time MBA has on our Change Makers, facilitating meaningful career transformations.

Post-MBA, the most sought-after sectors are Financial Services (28.6 %) and Consulting (27.3 %) closely followed by Technology, reflecting the informed choices our graduates are making to shape their professional paths.

We are delighted to celebrate not only the successes of

this resilient cohort, but also their commitment to our core values of curiosity, openness, restlessness, and excellence.

This report is a testament to the transformative journey taken by our Full-time MBA graduates, and we look forward to following their continued success in the ever-evolving landscape of global business.

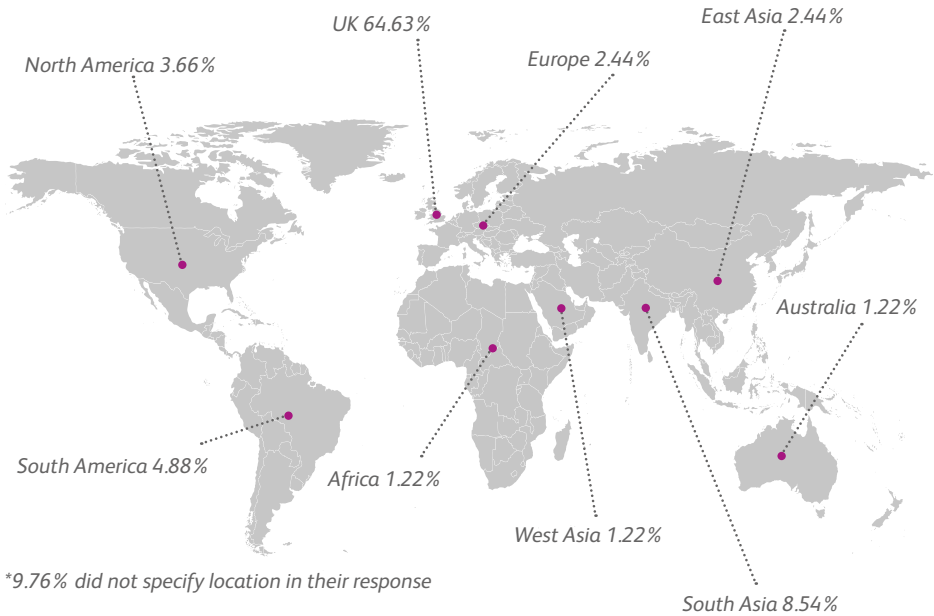

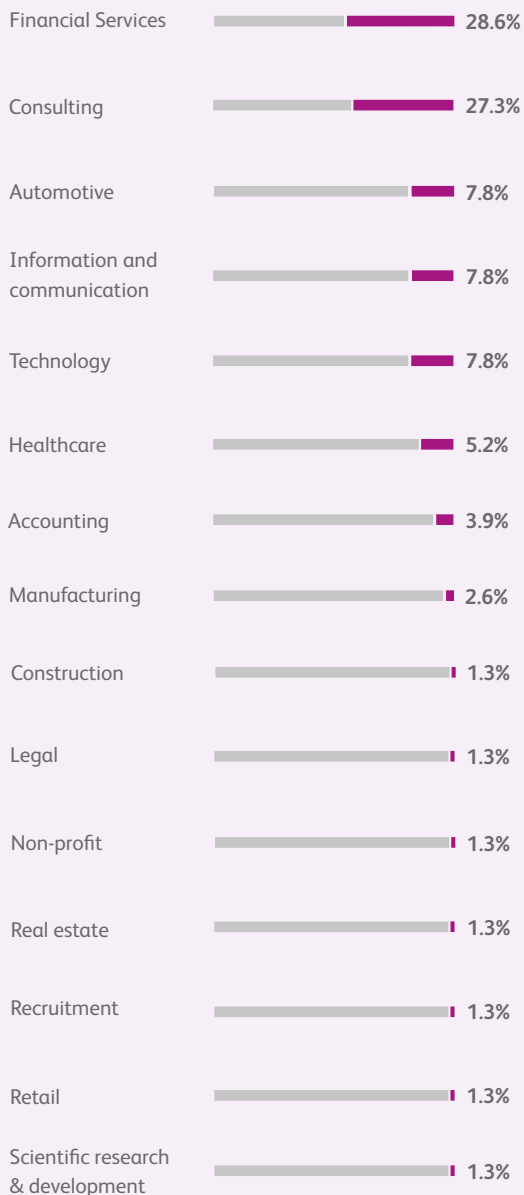

Identifying the most valuable careers intervention on the Full-time MBA is a challenge. After coaching, I think our Development Centres are a close second. Every participant is invited to take part in a Development Centre to practise their interview, presenting and groupwork skills. Participants are given a case study 48 hours in advance and, on the morning of Development Centre, are asked to prepare a presentation on a question connected to the case study. They also undertake a group task which involves working as part of a team to solve a problem which is also connected to the case study. Participants are observed by a panel of assessors during the day and provided with tailored feedback shortly afterwards. Our Development Centres prepare participants for the Assessment Centres that they may encounter as part of future recruitment processes.”

The Employer Relations team collaborates closely with the MBA careers coaches to facilitate student access to various industries.
